### **What You CANNOT Do**

- Save grain from your crop for replanting.
- Sell or give seed or grain to anyone else for planting.
- Clean or condition CSO grain for use as seed.
- Use CSO seed for breeding, or research.

### **Why It Matters**

- **Fairness:** Every farmer using a CSO variety agrees to the same terms.
- **Support for Breeding:** Royalties fuel public wheat breeding and variety development.
- **Future Varieties:** Your compliance keeps the pipeline of improved genetics strong.
